

Use of electronic web conferences in standardization

DIN's internet conference solution gives its external partners opportunity to take part in meetings while reducing travel time and expenses.

These 'virtual' sessions enable participants to engage in active dialogue with other committee members, whether to share presentations or develop documents, without leaving the office.

Scheduling of meetings is also easier, since arrangements can be made at shorter notice without attendees having to reserve whole days in their diaries because of long journey times. As a result, information and decision-making processes can be speeded up.

You will need a PC with internet and telephone connection.

Users will receive the invitation to a web conference together with all relevant information by e-mail. As soon as the accompanying links are activated, the software on your computer will be quickly configured to enable you to use the conference facility. This does not usually require any special knowledge or authorization on the part of users.

System requirements according to manufacturer:

Windows-based systems:

Operating system:	Windows 2000, 2003, XP or Vista
Memory:	256 MB RAM or higher
Monitor resolution:	VGA 800 * 600 or higher
Bandwidth capacity:	56 KBit/s or higher
Browser:	Internet Explorer 6 or higher

Web-based systems:

Operating system:	Windows 2000 or higher, Mac OS V10.3 or higher, Solaris 10 or higher
Monitor resolution:	VGA 800 * 600 or higher
Bandwidth capacity:	56 KBit/s or higher
Browser:	Internet Explorer 6 (SP2) or higher, Firefox 2 or higher, Safari 1.3 or higher
Java runtime environment:	Java version 1.5.11 or higher (for Apple: Java 1.4.2)

In our experience, however, users of other common systems such as Linux/Firefox can also take part.
