- 1. Educational purposes are deemed to exist if a state educational institution carries out the reproduction for the non-commercial education of its trainees and marks the reproduction in accordance with No. 7.
- 2. A fee is due for all reproductions, irrespective of their format size, which reflect the original text of a DIN Standard either wholly or partially, and irrespective of whether the text is given verbatim or insubstantially modified. Examples of insubstantial modifications are the inclusion of the name of the teaching institution or of a serial number, and the omission or modification of the frame enclosing the text.
- 3. With the granting of permission to reproduce, DIN assumes no guarantee for the correctness of the reproduction. The permission to reproduce shall only extend to the number of reproductions permitted in each case. Each new reproduction requires a new permission.
- 4. If the reproduction is handed out to the trainees on loan in a printed version exclusively during lessons and collected again at the end, DIN shall not charge a reproduction fee for this, provided that DIN has received written confirmation from the teaching institution.
- 5. If the reproduction is issued to the trainees for retention, a fee shall be paid for the reproduction, which shall amount to 20 % of the respective retail price of the DIN Standard per reproduction/copy. Reproduction in extracts (individual pages of the standard) will be charged on a pro rata basis.
- 6. If the standard is made accessible online, it may only be made accessible via an access-restricted system to authorized users via secure authentication for reading purposes. Any use beyond this is not permitted, in particular downloading, printing or making available to third parties who are not authorized users (i.e. in particular freely on the Internet). "Authorized users" are the trainees and teachers participating in the specific training course. A fee shall be paid for making the standard available, which shall amount to 20 % of the respective sales price of the DIN Standard for each participating trainee.
- 7. Any reproduction shall be clearly marked by the teaching institution with the following information:
 - Name of the teaching institution;
 - Name of the specific training course for which the reproduction is used;
 - Reference to copyright protection and restricted rights of use
 - ("DIN standards are protected by copyright.
