

## SEMINAR PURPOSES

### Special Reproduction Conditions

1. Seminar purposes are deemed to apply if a seminar provider (for example, a training provider or a state educational institution) carries out the reproduction for a specific seminar and marks it in accordance with No. 4 below.
2. The seminar provider is permitted to use the DIN standard either
  - a. to be reproduced once for each participant and each teacher/speaker in printed form (paper) and handed out for retention, or
  - b. to be made available online in electronic form (PDF) exclusively for the participants and teachers/speakers via an access-restricted system using secure authentication (i.e. in particular, not freely available on the internet) exclusively for reading purposes (i.e. in particular, without the possibility of downloading or printing) for the duration of the seminar.
3. A fee for reproduction shall be paid by the seminar provider to DIN in the amount of a percentage of the sales price of the respective duplicated DIN Standard per participant and teacher/speaker; reproduction of excerpts (e.g. individual pages of a DIN Standard) shall be charged according to the percentage share. The percentage share for seminar purposes is 50 %. The percentage share is reduced to 20 % if the reproduction is carried out by a state educational institution for the non-commercial training of its trainees.
4. Any reproduction shall be clearly marked by the seminar provider with the following information:
  - Name of the seminar provider;
  - Name of the specific seminar for which the reproduction is used;
  - Reference to copyright protection and restricted rights of use ("DIN standards are protected by copyright. For seminar use only. Any unauthorized reproduction or distribution is not permitted.").
