

1. "Use of DIN Standards in a software product" is understood to be when DIN Standards are included in software in order to give users of the software read-access to the DIN Standards when using the software. Software is any application programme designed by programming language that enables users to control computer-controlled processes by providing their own input. It includes calculation modules, applications for mobile phones, web applications, tools, etc.
2. The software provider is permitted to
  - a. save the DIN Standards in the software product and
  - b. make them exclusively available to authorized users of the software product via an access-restricted system using secure authentication (i.e. in particular, not freely available on the internet) exclusively for reading purposes (i.e. in particular, without the possibility of downloading or printing).
3. The software provider guarantees to make every reasonable effort to enable only authorized users to have access to the DIN Standards and to use the DIN Standards exclusively according to the provisions of the permission to reproduce them.
4. A reproduction fee shall be paid by the software provider to DIN. This shall be 4% of the sales price of the respective reproduced DIN Standard per named user able to read the DIN Standard by using the software; reproduction of excerpts (e.g. individual pages of a DIN Standard) shall be charged according to the percentage share.
5. For the purpose of calculating the reproduction fee for the calendar year, not later than three months after expiry of each calendar year the software provider shall notify DIN in text form of the number of named users newly registered in that year.
